## Pond House Entrance

### Site conditions:

Sun/shade: Sunny to edge of woods

Moist/wet/dry: Dry, average. Some access to water on site; no irrigation system.

### Notes:

1. Paved path to picnic area on south side of driveway; branch of path goes to entrance of building.
2. Dumpster in SE corner of parking lot may be repositioned within parking lot.
3. Perennial/annual beds along guardrail at curves of parking lot and in front of building must be kept but suggestions for plant material may be included.
